A RESOLUTION PROVIDING EXEMPTION FROM AD VALOREM TAXATION UNDER SECTION 13, ARTICLE 11 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF KANSAS FOR COX MACHINE, INC.

WHEAREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Harper County, Kansas, by Resolution No. _____ has adopted a policy for the granting of exemptions from ad valorem taxation for economic development purposes as authorized by Section 13, Article 11 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas;

WHEAREAS, Cox Machine Inc., has formally applied for tax exemption to the City of Harper by an application filed with the City Clerk of the City of Harper, Kansas. A copy of the application is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein;

WHEREAS, the tax exemption requested applies to property located within the jurisdiction of Harper County, Kansas;

WHEREAS, the application has been reviewed by the Board of County Commissioners in accordance with its policy and has found the proposed project is one contemplated and within the purpose of Section 13, Article 11 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas and meets the eligibility requirements of the Harper County Policy for the Granting of Exemptions from Ad Valorem Taxation for Economic Development Purposes;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners did participate in the public hearing on February 22, 2016, during a regular meeting of the Harper City Council with a representative of the county commission in attendance;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners supports the tax exemption made by the City of Harper, Kansas for Economic Development Purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HARPER COUNTY, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Cox Machine, Inc. shall be granted a 100% tax exemption for the 14,000 sq. ft. building expansion for a term of ten years.

Section 2. The tax exemption shall apply to the new construction located on the property located at 949 N. HWY 14, Harper, Kansas, 67058.

Section 3. The tax exemption may be revoked and funds required to be returned if there is failure to meet the conditions set forth in the approved application for ad valorem tax exemption.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective upon publication in the official county newspaper.
