

Commissioner Updates – 8/29/2016

Working half days for next couple of weeks, so still (as last report)...

- Give Kristy & Melinda the administrator password and show them a few routine operational things to watch. (Email services, server settings, AS/400 maintenance, etc)
- Kitty will swap AS/400 backup tapes.
- Matt will wind clock.
- Even when I am home, I will work remote as much as needed/possible.

Recovery from lightning or other power surge...

- Mostly everything is working fine. There are a few network issues I need to still remedy a couple things I did to get by. This is in the connection between the Courthouse and the LEC, which impacts the Health and Road & Bridge buildings. It is mostly a speed issue, and I hope to make it better than it was to begin with.
- Repairs involved...
 - A/C on 3rd floor (control board replaced)
 - Elevator (control boards replaced)
 - Several sensors in the alarm system
 - One large network switch (and fiber adapter) in the computer room
 - Wireless from Courthouse to Anthony EMS and to Noxious Weeds
 - Two small network switches in LEC and fiber adapter
 - Network card in the Sheriff server
 - WiFi in the Law Library
 - The last “repair” is a sensor installed by Hazel’s (as instructed by Sandifer Engineering) on Friday morning as I write this report. I have other equipment in the computer room for the network remedies mentioned earlier.

“Major” crises after surgery...

- Console problems in Dispatch (phone control/old CAD PC). Would not run, fixed this the Monday I returned to work half days (Aug 22).
- Crown Phones in the jail quit working. Worked some remote in an attempt to get this working, then spent most of 2 days(half) after I returned.
- Most other things were minor issues.
